Following Technical Briefing the following points of clarification were sought:-

##### Memorabilia

The Applicant has confirmed that there is no hand print with initials for Gregory Peck within the site area.

##### Parking

The applicant has confirmed that the sound stages and their associated workshops will have no permanent staff. Film crews will use these buildings for precise filming periods and they will not have an on-site editing function. Crew staff are required to travel by public transport and the crews will vary in size but are comparatively small in number. This is in complete contrast to the Big Brother House that was formerly on this site. It included an editing function, employed 450 people with approximately 150 people on site at any one time and operated 24 hour a day. There will, by comparison, be a major reduction in people on site.

## Water Tank

The applicant has advised that prior to making the planning application they examined the possibility of retaining the existing concrete water tank in whole or part to assist with rainwater disposal. It was not viable and so the existing water tank will be broken up during construction. Rainwater harvesting for flushing the toilets alongside the sound stages is possible but would not re-use the existing tank.

An Informative is therefore added to the recommendation for the applicant to explore rainwater harvesting for the toilet block on the site.
