Four questions have been received from members of the public, in accordance with Council Procedure Rule 10:

Public Question PQ2019-19 to Councillor Graham

From: Pat Garrett, Borehamwood

"With reference to the ever increasing works going on at this site, I ask you to please intervene to put an end to the constant HGV noise of 17 Tonne trucks pulling up outside my home next to the site entrance at well before 8am some days with engines revving.

The trucks arriving is a constant stream. The noise is unbearable. I have to have the windows closed in this current heat.

12 feet from my front door is not part of the construction site.

The pavement AND my crossover to my drive, that I have just paid to have installed, have been damaged.

I ask Cllr Graham, as per the Human Rights act 1998 , under Article 1 (every person is entitled to the peaceful enjoyment of his possessions) and Article 8 (everyone has the right to respect for his private family life), will he seek to approach the contractors and put a stop to this invasion of privacy."
